## Basic Crochet Beanie

## This simple pattern is cute as it is or add embellishments such as crocheted flowers or the Game Changer Crochet Pom Pom.

## Difficulty <br> Beginner

## Finished Measurements

Head Circumference in inches
Preemie (Newborn, Infant, Toddler,
Child): 12 ( $13,14,16,18$ )
Adult Small (Large): 20 (23)

## Materials

1 ball Cascade 220
( $100 \mathrm{~g} / 220 \mathrm{yds}$ )
US Size G (4mm)hook
Tapestry needle

## Gauge

$16 \mathrm{dc}=4$ inches
10 rows $=4$ inches

Note on sizing: For best results, choose a size that is slightly smaller than your head measurement so the beanie will stretch a little bit when you wear it.

Before beginning, I recommend highlighting the instructions for the size you will be making.

In each rnd, place the first st in the same st as beg ch.

## Crown Shaping

## All sizes begin here.

Rnd 1: In magic lp, ch 2 (does not count as a st throughout), 10 dc . Join w sl st to

first dc. (10 dc)
Rnd 2: Ch 2, 2 dc in each st around. Join. (20 dc)

Rnd 3: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next st] around. Join. (30 dc)

Rnd 4: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts ] around. Join. ( 40 dc )

## For Preemie Size only

Rnd 5: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 7 sts ] around. Join. ( 45 dc )

For Preemie Size, continue to next section.

## All larger sizes continue crown shaping.

Rnd 5: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next

3 sts ] around. Join. (50 dc)
Stop here for Newborn Size ony. Continue to next section.

## For Infant Size only

Rnd 6: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 9 sts ] around. Join. (55 dc)

For Infant Size, continue to next section.

## All larger sizes continue crown shaping.

Rnd 6: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts ] around. Join. ( 60 dc )

Stop here for Toddler Size ony. Continue to next section.

Rnd 7: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next $5 \mathrm{sts}]$ around. Join. (70 dc)

Stop here for Child Size ony. Continue to next section.

Rnd 8: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 6 sts ] around. Join. $(80 \mathrm{dc})$

Stop here for Adult Small Size ony. Continue to next section.

Rnd 9: Ch 2, [2 dc in next st, dc in next 7 sts ] around. Join. ( 90 dc )

## Continue Beanie

Rnd 1: Ch 2, dc in each st around. Join. 45 (50, 55, 60, 70) $80(\mathbf{9 0}) \mathrm{dc}$
$5,6,7) \mathbf{8 ( 1 0 )}$ inches from top of crown or desired length.

## Ribbing

If desired, add ribbing as follows.
On the last rnd, if st count is an odd number, dc2tog in first st so that st count is an even number.

Rnd 1: Ch 2, [fpdc in next st, dc in next st] around. Join.

Rpt rnd 1 as desired.
Finish off. Weave in ends. ©
