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crochet

Joy is the warmth of spring, delighting in the flavors of fresh recipes, and the dazzling colors inspired by What's Cookin' 2021 by JemsLuxe Fibers. Fill your senses with joy as you immerse yourself in creating this shawl!

Difficulty

Advanced Beginner



Finished Measurements

Approx. 60 inches by 32 inches after blocking

Materials

What's Cookin' from
Jems Luxe Fibers



1 skein DK Luxe in each color:
Carrot Suffle C1
Pig Pie C2
Blueberry Rumble C3

US Size H (5mm) hook

Tapestry needle

Gauge

5 sc = 1 inch

Gauge not critical



Notes

Repeat instructions in [brackets] the number of times indicated.

To Change Color

On the last stitch before each color change, change to the new color by pulling the last loop of the last single crochet with the new color.

Special Stitch

Spike Stitch (spst): yo, insert hook in stitch 3 rows below, pull up lp, [yo, pull through 2 lps on hook] twice.

Begin Shawl

With C1, begin with ML.

Row 1 (RS): 3 sc in ML. Or ch 2, 3 sc in second ch from hook. Turn.
3 sc

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc to end. Turn.
4 sc

Row 3: Ch 1, sc to last st, 2 sc in next st. Turn.
5 sc

Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in next st, sc to end. Turn.
6 sc

Rpt last 2 rows until you have 14 sts ending on a WS.

Mesh Section

Row 1 (RS): Ch 1, sc to last st, 2 sc in next st. Turn.
15 sc

Row 2: Ch 5, sl st in 5th st, [ch 5, sk ext 3 sts, sl st in next st] to last 2 sts, ch 2, sk next st, dc in last st. Turn.
3 ch-5 sps, 1 ch-2 sp

Row 3: [Ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp] across, ch 5, dc in last ch (be sure to place st in ch and not sp) of last ch-5 sp. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 8, sl st in first ch-5 sp, [Ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp] across, ch 2, dc in last ch of last ch-5 sp. Turn.

Row 5: Ch 3, 3 dc in ch-2 sp, [sl st in next ch-5 sp, ch 3, 3 dc in same sp as sl st] across, sl st in ch-8 sp, ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, dc in third ch from end of ch-8 sp. Turn.

Row 6: Ch 8, sl st in first ch-3 sp, [Ch 5, sl st in next ch-3 sp] across, ch 2, dc in last ch of last ch-3 sp. Turn.

Row 7: [Ch 5, sl st in next ch-5 sp] across, ch 5, sl st in ch-8 sp, ch 5, dc in third ch from end of ch-8 sp. Turn.

Row 8: Ch 5, sc in first ch-5 sp, [ch 3, sc in next ch-5 sp] across, ch 1, dc in last ch of last ch-5 sp. Turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in first st, sc in ch-1 sp, [sc in next st, 3 sc in ch-3 sp] to last ch-5 sp, 3 sc in last ch-5 sp, sc in third ch from end of ch-5 sp. Turn.
27 sc

Row 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc to end changing to C2 for last lp.
28 sc (You will have a multiple of 4 sts at the end of each Mesh Section.)

Mosaic Crochet Section

Row 1: Using C2 ch 1, sc to last st, 2 sc in last st. Turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc to end changing to C1 in the last lp. Turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, [sc in next 3 sts, spst, sc in next 2 sts] across to last 4 sts, sc in next 3 sts, 2 sc in last st. Turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc to end changing to C2 in the last lp. Turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, [sc in next 2 sts, spst, sc in next st, spst, sc in next st] across to last 5 sts, sc in next st, spst, sc in next 2 sts, 2 sc in last st. Turn.

Row 6: Rpt row 2.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first 2 sts, [sc in next st, spst, sc in next 3 sts, spst] across to last 8 sts, sc in next st, spst, sc in next 5 sts, 2 sc in last st. Turn.

Row 8: Rpt row 4. Finish off C1.

Row 9: Ch 1, [spst in next st, sc in next 5 sts] across to last 10 sts, spst, sc in next 8 sts, 2 sc in last st. Turn.

Row 10: Ch 1, 2 sc in first st, sc to end. Turn.

(You will have a multiple of 4 plus 2 sts at the end of each Mesh Section.)

Rpt Mesh Section using C2. Rpt Mosaic Crochet Section using C2 and C3.

Rpt Mesh Section using C3. Rpt Mosaic Crochet Section using C3 and C1.


Rpt each color combination once more ending with C1.

Edging

Rpt Mesh Section rows 1-5 using C1. Finish off C1.

Change to C2. Work Mesh Section row 6. Then work Mesh Section rows 3-5. Finish off C2.

Change to C3. Work Mesh Section row 6. Then work Mesh Section rows 3-5. Finish off C3.

Weave in ends. Block aggressively or as desired. When blocking I recommend pinning each point of the last row to highlight the shape of the edging. Also, if necessary adjust the slip stitches to square up the mesh.

ML = magic loop
rpt = repeat
RS = right side
sc = single crochet
sk = skip
sl st = slip stitch
sp(s) = space(s)
spst = spike stitch
WS = wrong side

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
